



**Enrolled Members by Major Category for Dorchester County SFY09**




**Dorchester County Federally Matched Medicaid Eligibles SFY09 Compared with Total Census Population**

**Dorchester County Federally Matched Medicaid Members by Eligibility Category SFY09\***


